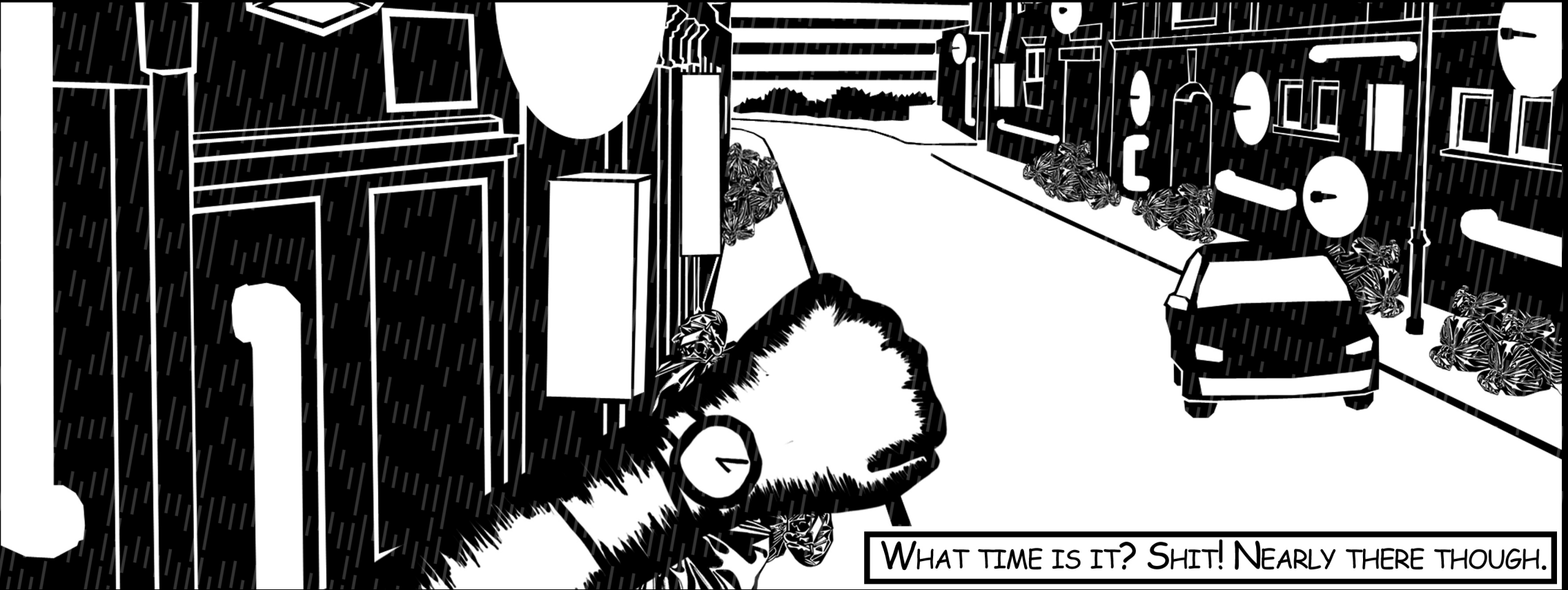

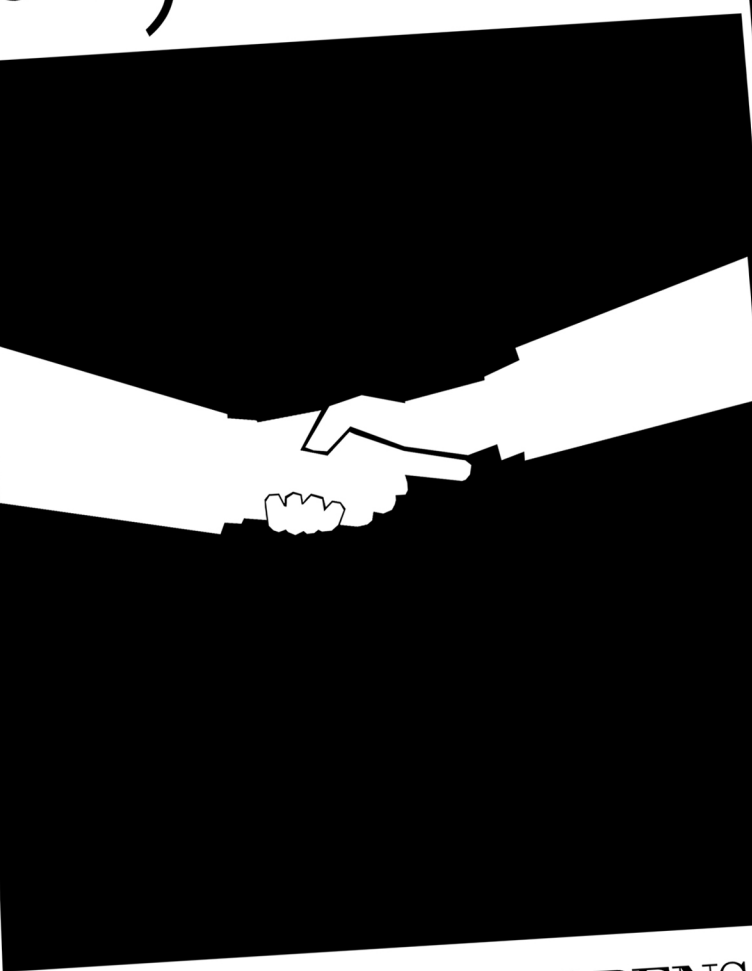

Lee was and army officer and journalist prior to becoming a restaurateur. His four marriages all ended in divorce and he was also declared bankrupt.



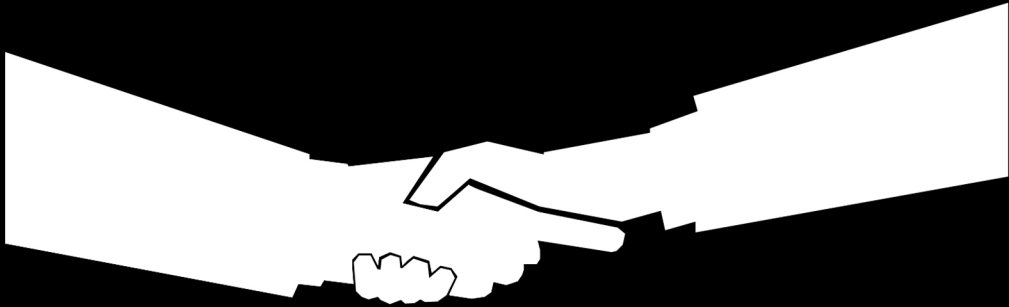

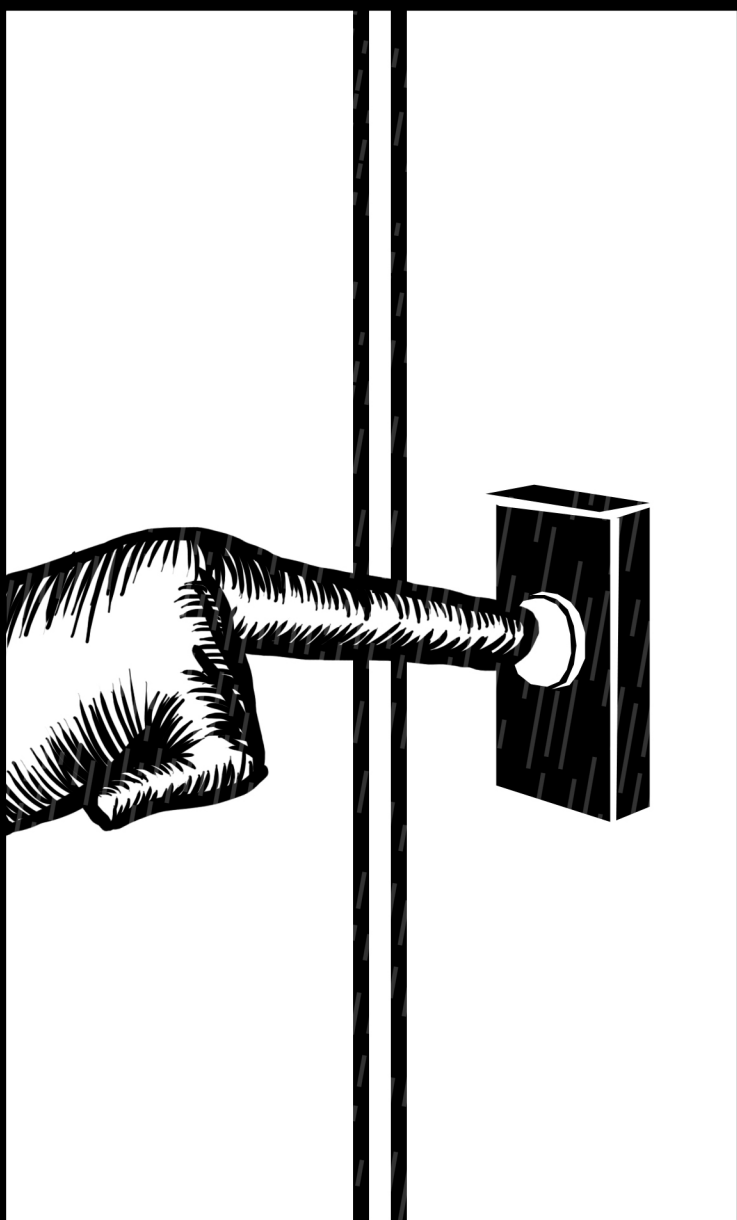
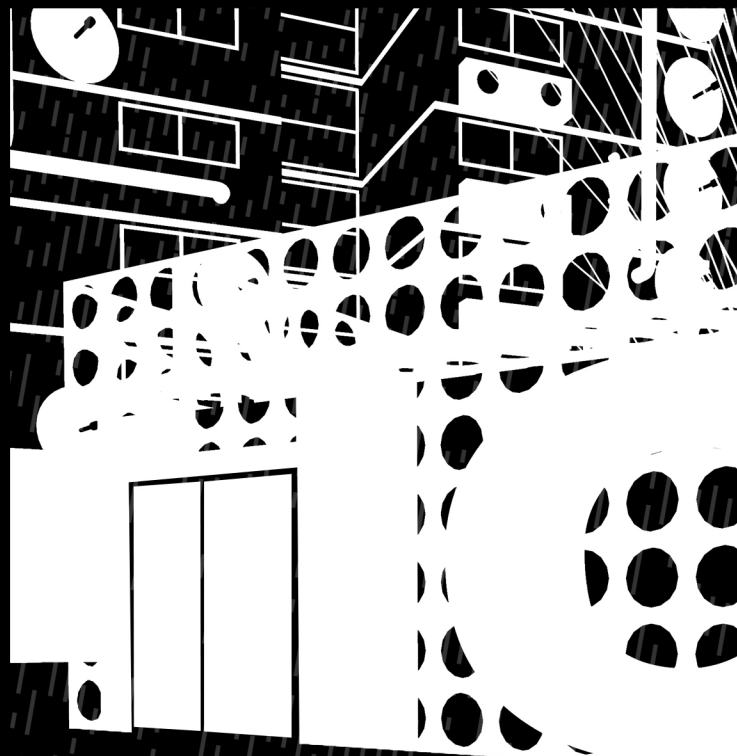
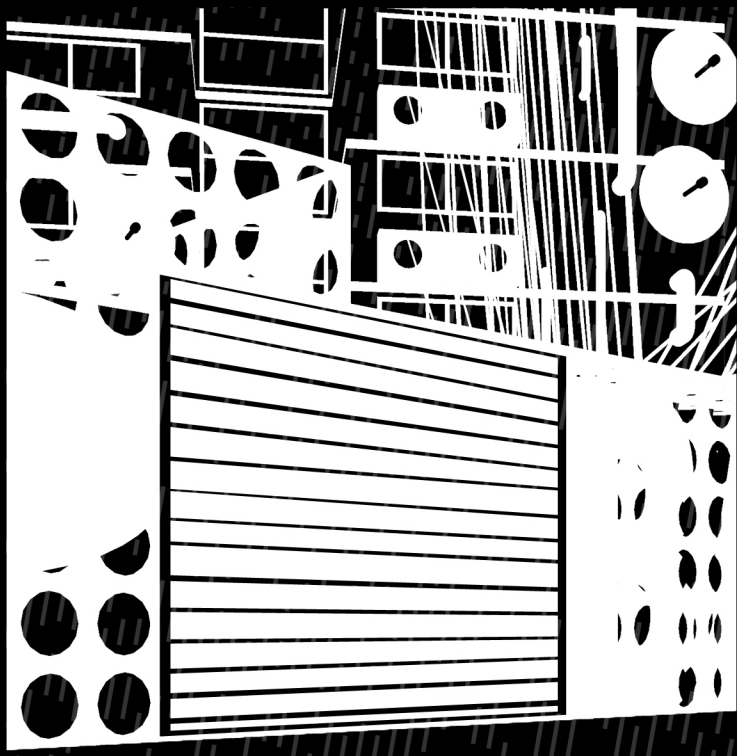
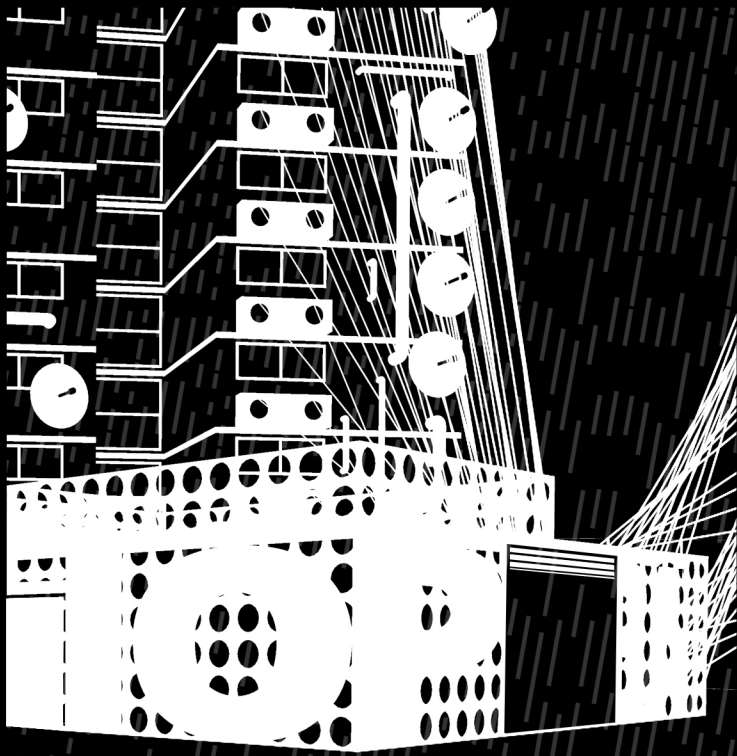
Heart attack kills TV chef Bernard Lee
